

ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

Power Lines, Pipes and Cables Ltd (PLPC Ltd) is a family run business that was established in 1973 to provide a power line construction service to Distribution Network Operators (DNO) across the UK. PLPC Ltd supply and install overhead power lines and fibre optic systems to DNO's and private clients.

We acknowledge our environmental responsibility and have integrated our environmental accountabilities into the company's management systems, including policies, objectives, procedures and processes. These are developed and reviewed during regular management and annual strategic reviews and ensure compliance with the requirements of ISO 14001:2015, National Electricity Registration Scheme (NERS) and associated industry codes, customer, statutory and regulatory requirements.

- Liaise with customers, suppliers and sub-contractors to influence their environmental performance
- Reduce where practical, emissions to the environment through a programme of waste, where possible minimising and reducing energy usage across all business areas
- Adopt an environmentally sound transport strategy
- Undertake practical environmental training for all employees and encourage good environmental practices at work and in the home
- Minimise noise and emissions from plant and equipment
- Have appropriate emergency plans in place for work sites and premises
- Improve the management system to enhance our environmental performance
- Protect the environment and prevent pollution by implementing and adhering to a framework of policies, procedures and processes that comply with the requirements of BS EN ISO 14001:2015
